- The students were acquainted with the rich educational and cultural heritage of Serampore

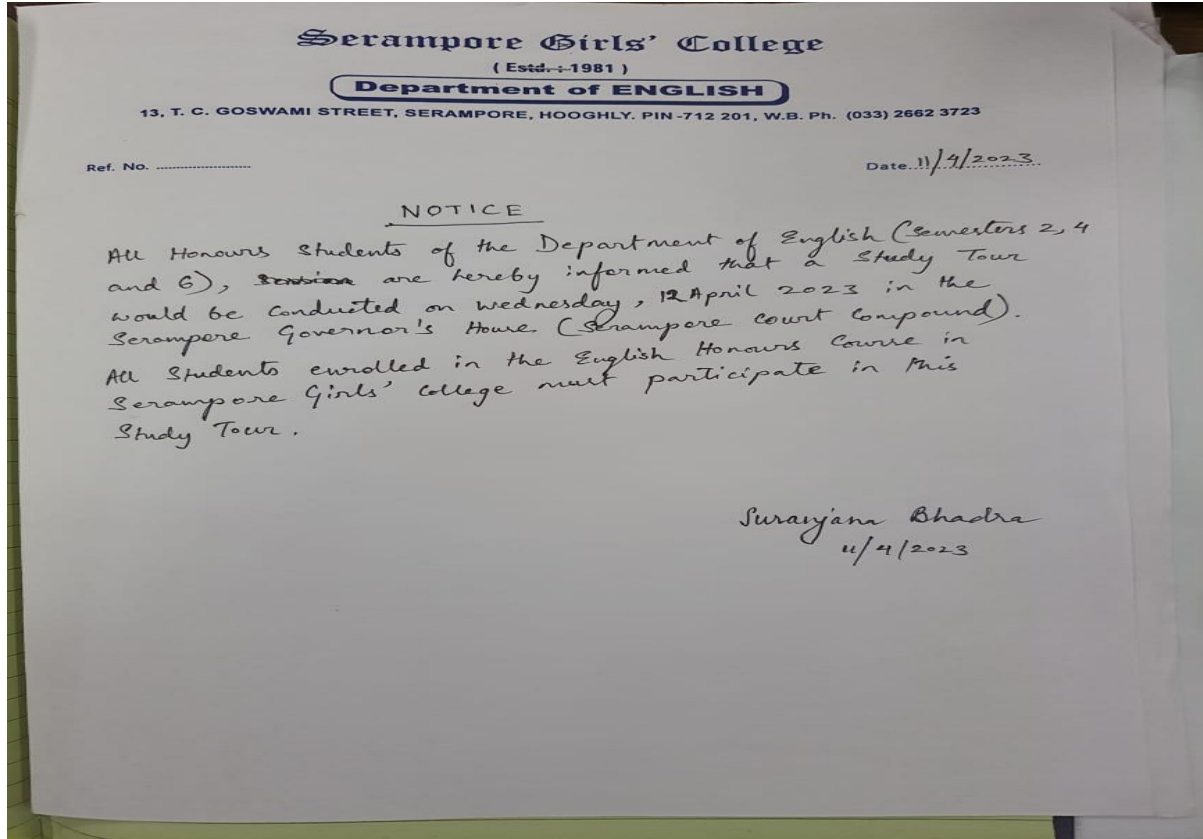
