- To impart relevant vital knowledge on how to cope and survive the aftermath of domestic abuse.

Outcome:

- Students understand the meaning of gender-based violence against women and girls as a human rights violation
- Students could realize that taking a stand on gender-based violence against women and girls - and other forms of gender inequality affecting women - is an action that redresses existing harm and injustice that affects women.
- Students could understand the concept of survivor agency - that all initiatives need to be undertaken in cooperation with survivors, using safe, empowering, and respectful approaches.
- Students could identify the factors that need to be addressed - media, communications; substantive and procedural law; institutions - police, judiciary, workplaces, places of education, public spaces.
