
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NSOU shall control/monitor the functioning of the joint venture. The committee would, as and when necessary, will suggest to alter/modify and review the existing MOU for effective implementation of the course. All such alternations/modifications and review of the existing MOU shall be made in writing and be agreed upon by both the parties in order to be effective


- b) On all aspects where the above articles of understanding are silent or for special cases of deviation from these articles, the decision mutually agreed upon in writing between the parties will be final. However, in case of any dispute relating to or arising out of the MOU, such dispute shall be resolved amicably through Joint Committee constituted for the purpose with the consent of Vice-Chancellor, NSOU and joint committee's decision shall be final and binding on both parties with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor, NSOU.
- c) Either side could terminate this MOU by giving notice of at least three months in writing to the other side without causing any harm to the existing students who have not completed the course.





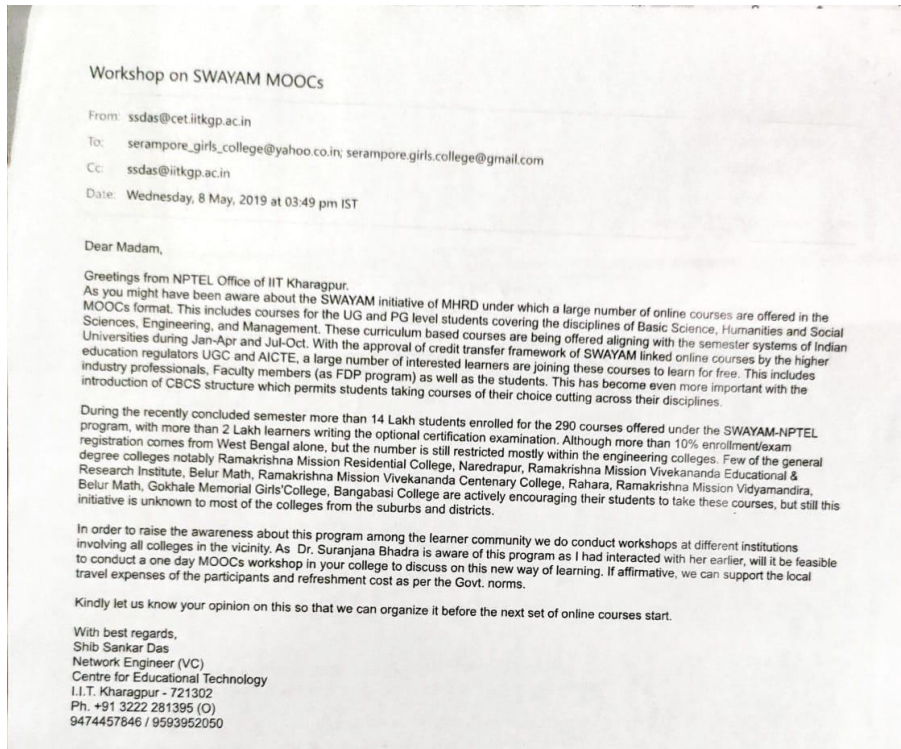
