Any other aspects not covered in this MoU, relevant to this program, and disputes etc arising about any aspect of the MoU shall be settled through mutual consultation and MoU, by the Parties to this MoU. In case a settlement is not arrived at, all disputes or differences arising between the parties in relation to the interpretation, meaning or effect of this MoU, or to any breach thereof and remain unresolved after the intervention of the representatives of the Parties, shall be referred to arbitration under the aegis of the Indian Council of Arbitration at New Delhi (ICA). The Rules of the ICA shall govern the arbitral proceedings between the Parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English and the venue for the arbitration proceedings shall be New Delhi.

3. This MoU will come into effect on the date of digitally signed by both Parties concerned and shall remain valid for a period of one year.
