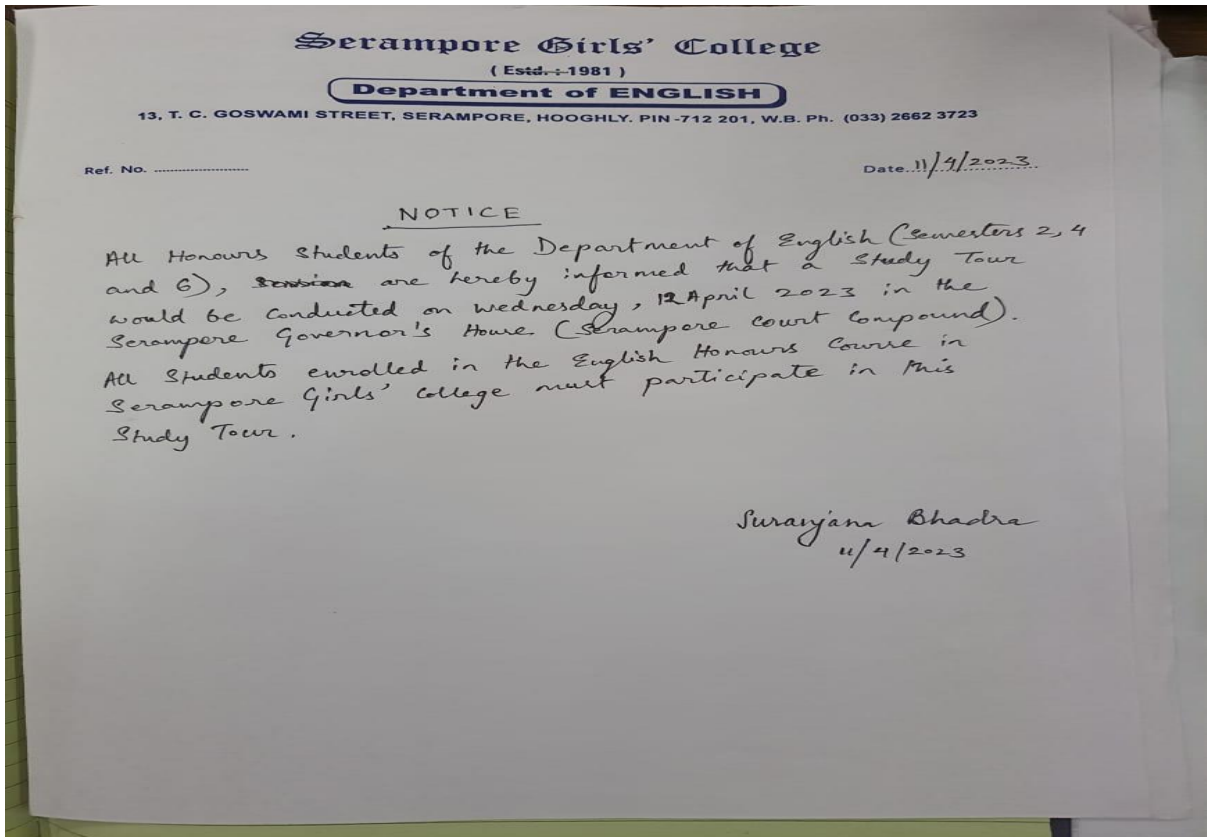

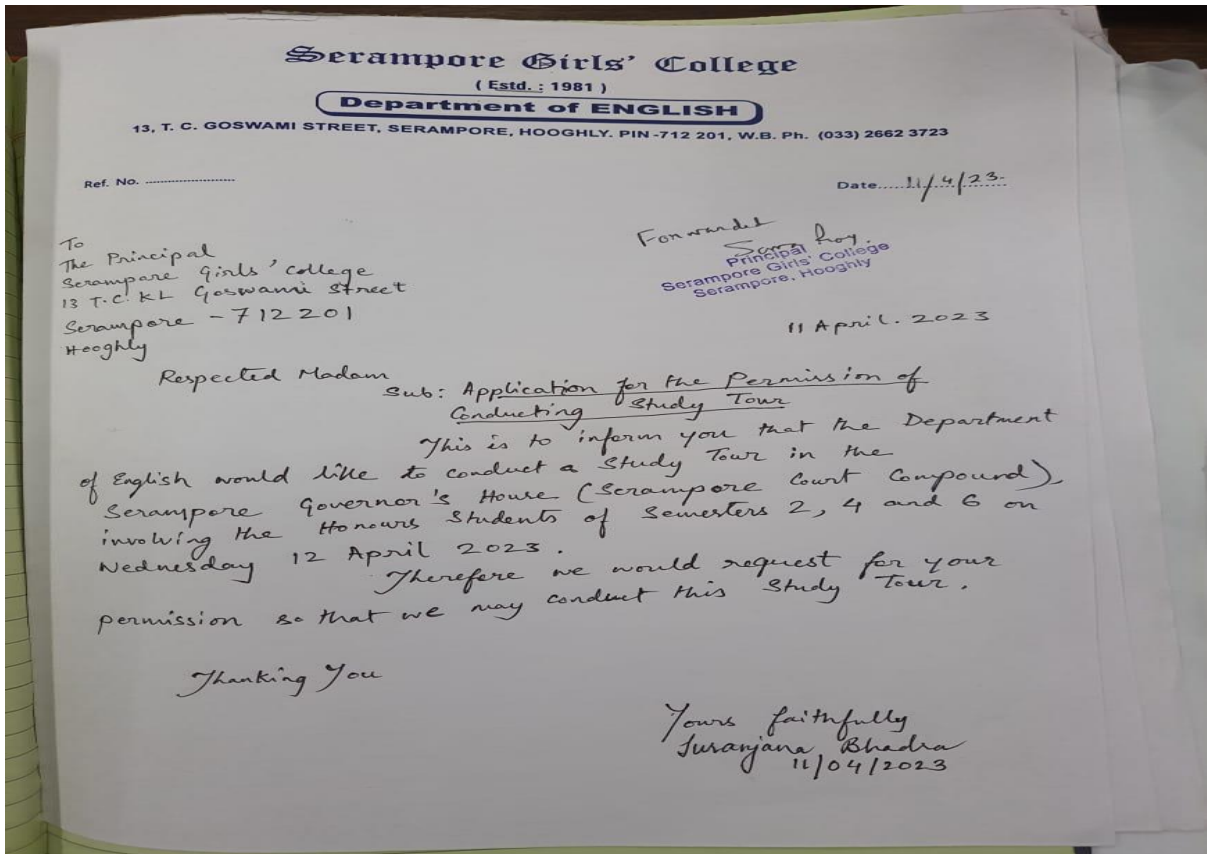
- The study tour to the Governor's House enriched our students immensely in an interdisciplinary way and the teachers benefitted no less than them.
