Number of attendees: (a) Student (mention semester): 1st SEM (40) and 3rd Year (30)

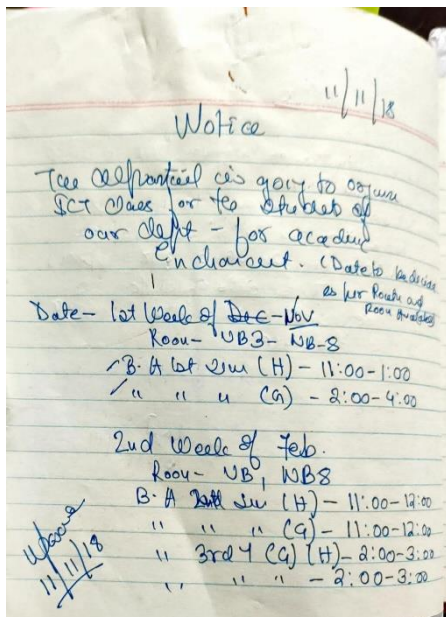
