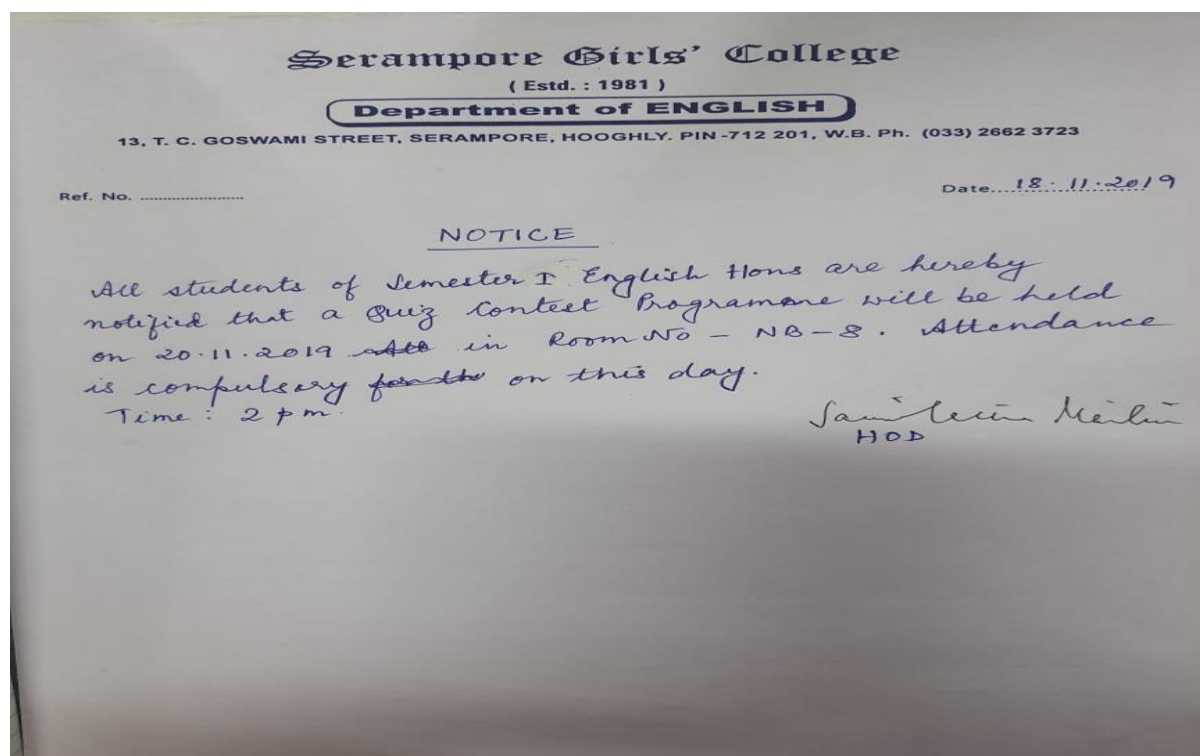

- Virtual platform-based competition gives a better experience to the participant.



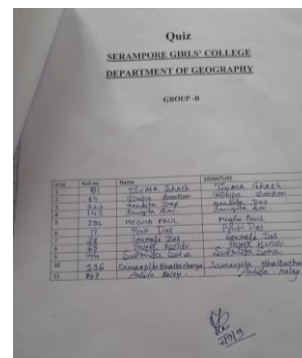
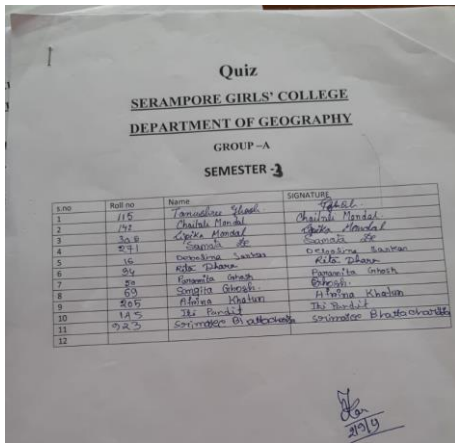
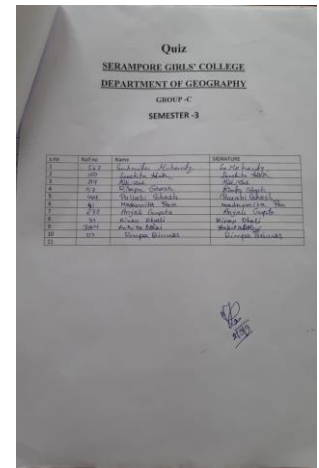
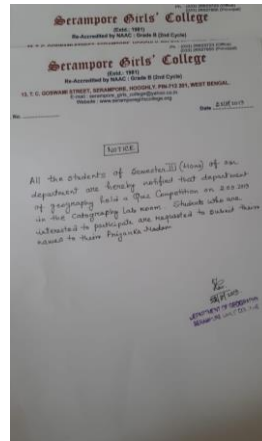
