WRITE-UPS BY THE SPEAKERS:

DRAMATIC GENRES IN THE ENGLISH RENAISSANCE – Dr Subhajit Sen Gupta

The paper focuses on the way genres were understood in Renaissance England. The rhetoricians of early modern England accept the possibility and the necessity of a hierarchical arrangement of genres. The paper begins with references to Sidney, who argues that each genre has a proper place and function. Sidney respects the generic prescriptions of the classicists but does not thoughtlessly imitate them. He argues, for example, that a dramatist needs to follow the unities not merely because Aristotle has said so but because it makes sense to follow them. While opposing the practice of mixing genres, Sidney asserts that common sense, rather than an unthinking adoption of tradition, should be our guide. On mixed genres, Sidney observes that there is no indecency nor discretion in the manner in which contemporary Elizabethan drama kings and clowns. The paper briefly addresses several other Renaissance discussions of

poetics which emphasize the notion of genre as an organizing principle. This preoccupation with genre theory during the English Renaissance stems, the paper asserts, from an increased interest in Horace and Aristotle, and from the eagerness of English writers to establish the respectability of their own language. The flexible approach to genres in the English Renaissance may have been vindicated by the social mobility and fluidity encouraged during the period. One characteristic feature of genre, therefore, is the identifiable recurrence of a common trait by which one may easily recognize a text as corresponding to a category. In this context, the paper shall glance at Jacques Derrida's 'The Law of Genre' where he says that every text participates in one or several genres, that there is no 'genreless' text, and that, in marking itself generically, a text unmarks itself.

DECONSTRUCTING SHAKESPEARE: READING THE UNREAD---Dr. Siddhartha Biswas

The Shakespearean enigma is a part of the appeal that Shakespearean texts continue to have. The person remains a mystery and even in a world which celebrates the death of the author, Shakespeare wields great power. Shakespearean texts have been revived more times than any other work from any other time or space. The so-called timelessness is a result of the absence of authorial imposition of meaning. These texts have allowed readings and re-readings, re-inventions and reconfigurations. They have been used for propaganda, they have been adopted by a variety of canons. In fact, the playwright whose existence itself is not beyond question has become such a phenomenon for the sole reason of the possibility of multiple connections and multiple layers that the plots and characters have in their construction. This paper intends to read certain political possibilities in four canonical plays - *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, *The Merchant of Venice*, *Macbeth* and *King Lear*. The fact that Shakespearean texts have a number of shades which allow the possibility of these often opposing significations - intended or unintended - show how the text itself can evolve beyond the context. The aim of the paper is not to problematize this factor, but to celebrate the freedom of the text.

About the Webinar:

Can a one-dimensional experience last a life time? And no matter whatever is put in the computer program making it as real as possible, would it ever be a substitute for a sudden experience that can force us to introspect and look inwards?

The pandemic- covid-19 has had its disastrous effect on us. As the world sits in front of millions of flat screens and maps the new reality by moving a cursor, the very definition of what constitutes reality may be undergoing a change to make the older reality fade away. This is guided by the fear in many that the physical world is not safe anymore and there is a comfort in the virtual, worth holding on to.

This topic is to be approached philosophically and discussed in relation with technocratic consciousness or the instrumentality of technology.

"Pandemic and the Interface between Lived Life and Virtual Life."

In the face of pandemic we are engaged in reorganizing our life. Our physical proximity is strictly prohibited, and our existence is coextensive with teleexistence – a virtual space.

Our lived life is real life which is full of sensory experiences of sight, smell, touch, taste, motion, temperature, pain, pleasure and other emotions. The experiences of lived life are open-ended. And, lived life is also a value-driven life aiming for well-being; it is a life that is actually lived through conscience, emotion and encountering.

Our lived life, on the contrary, lacks physicality and risk. But this view is subject to scrutiny and reconsideration.

However, virtual is not unreal or or mere fictional. David Chalmers has categorically said that virtual is a genuine, virtual objects are genuine objects. According to Phillip Brey, some virtual objects are not real; for example, an orange in virtual world cannot be tested. Such objects are not real. But, as John Searle has contended, there are some non-physical functional kinds of objects in the world which have ontological subjectivity and epistemic objectivity, for example social reality like friendship, legal rights and duties, library, college, university. They are institutional facts, and are real. They exist in collective consciousness.

Finally, it can be said, reality of lived life has certain elements which refuse to declare virtual life as an alternative to lived life: moral autonomy, physical touch and harm, suffering, openness of living, anxiety before freedom and death, hunger, uncertainty and wonder. During pandemic we have chosen the virtual world only to avoid physical proximity which might cause death.

Wall magazine

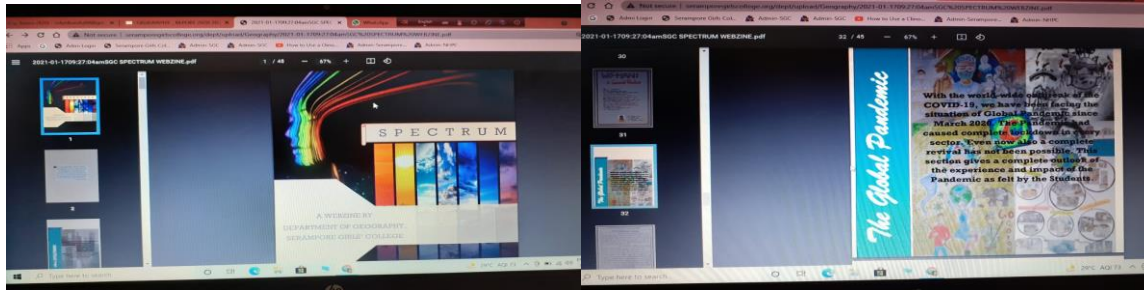

Objective of the Event

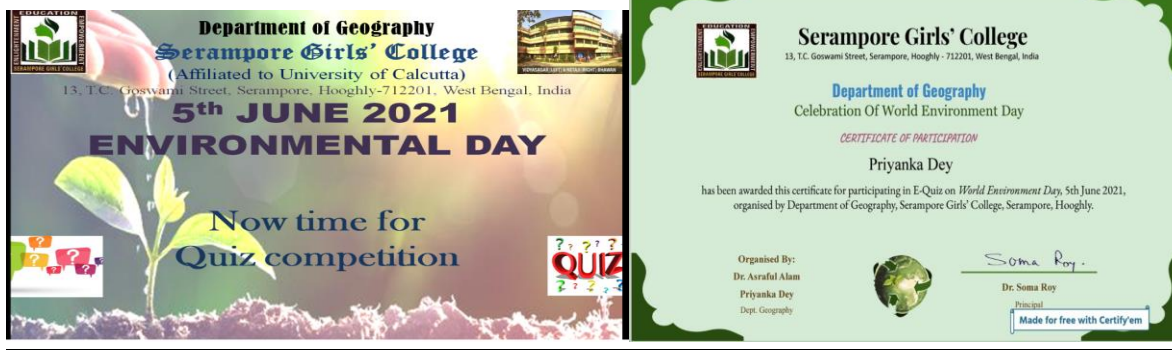

Poster Competition

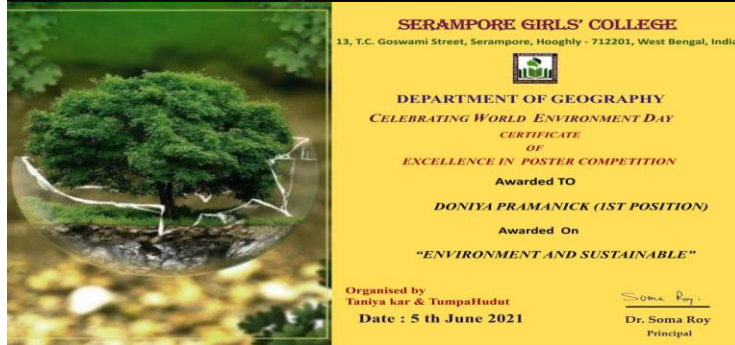
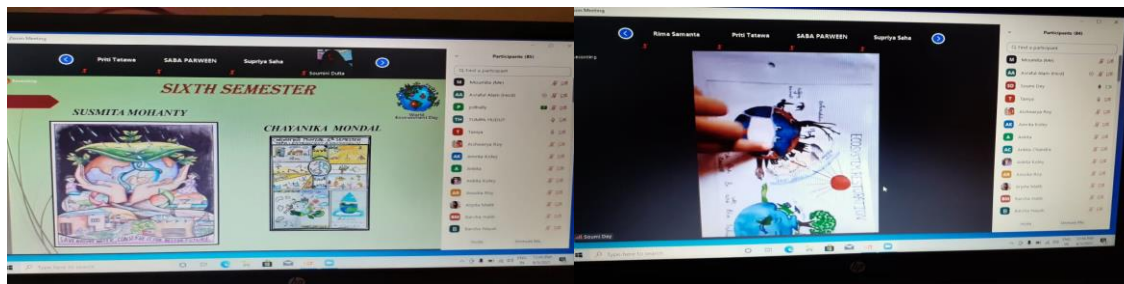
Objective:
