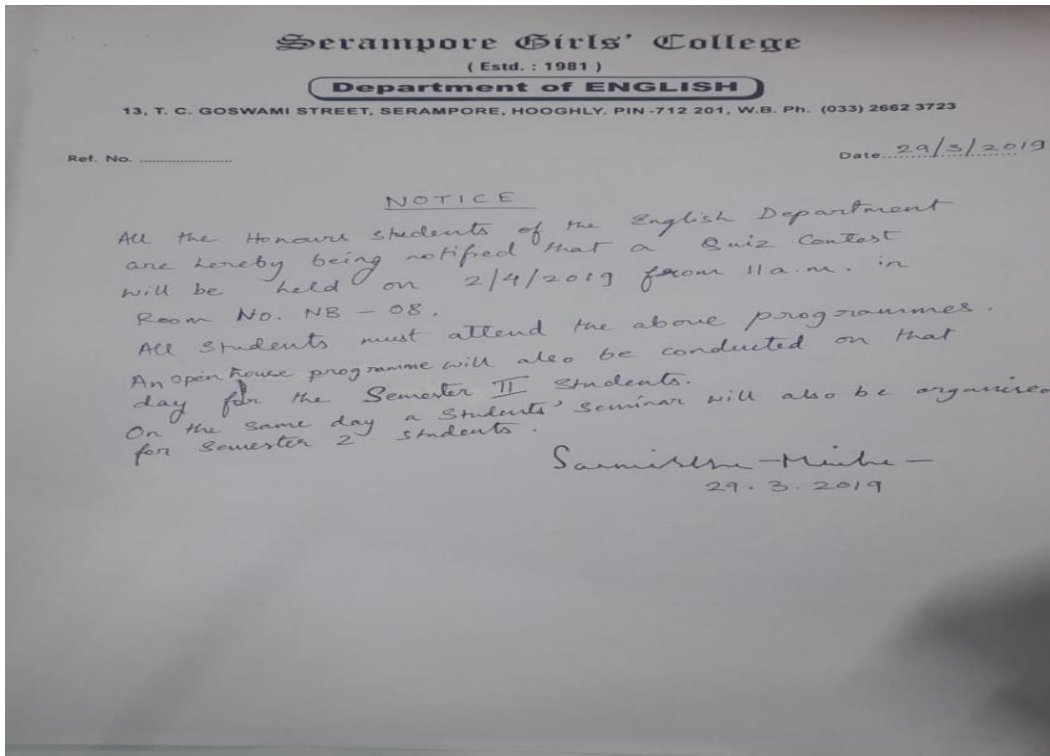

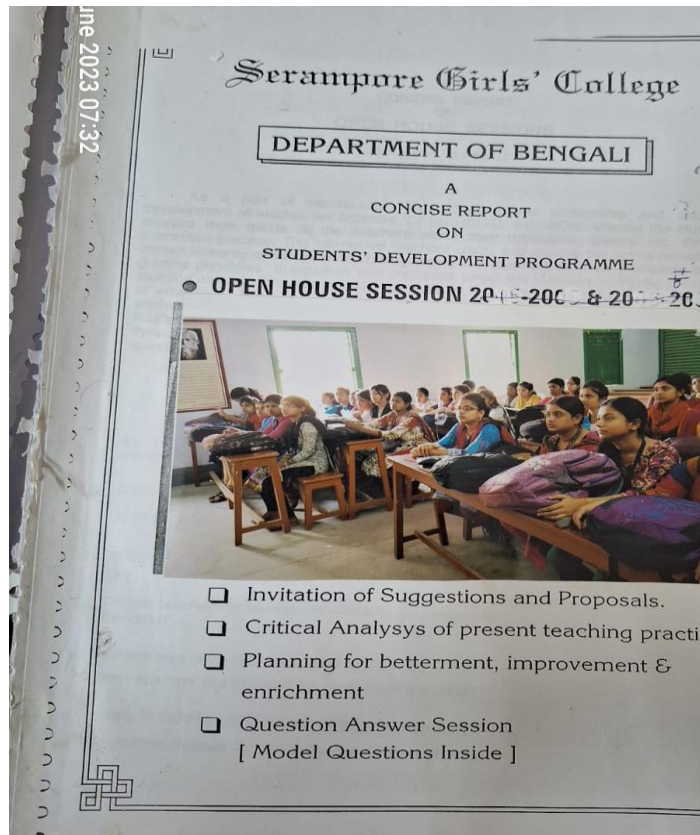

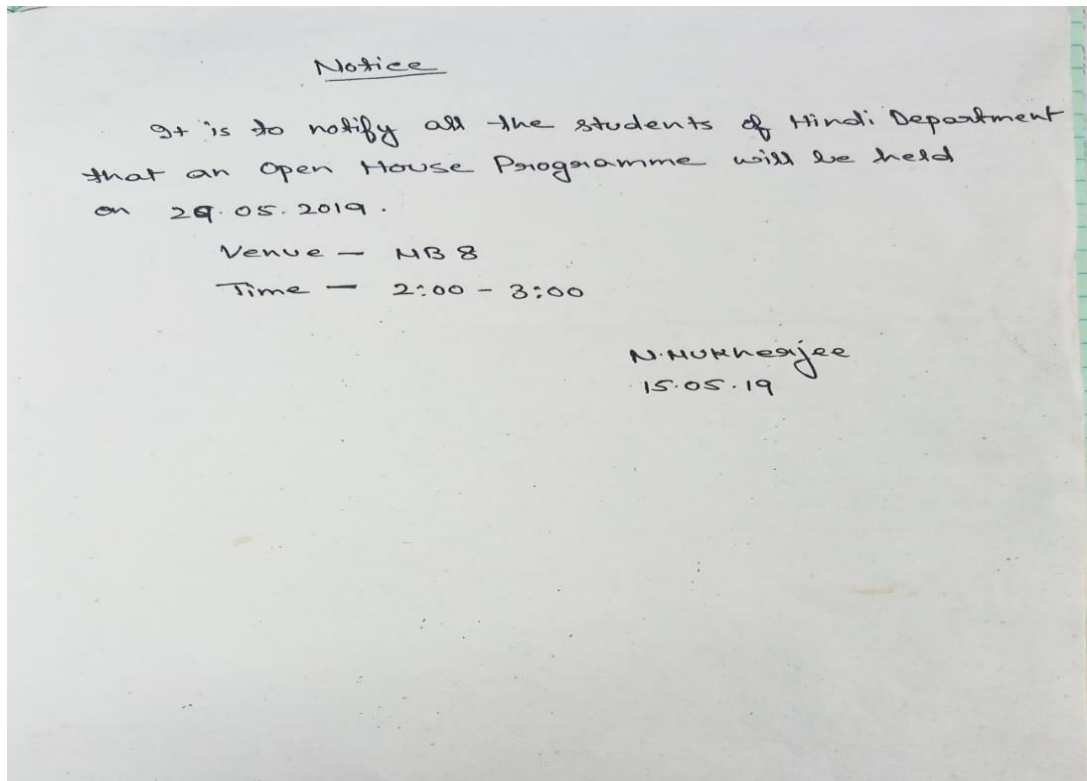
Objective of the events: To allow the students to speak and discuss about the Department and to get an overall view about the college.

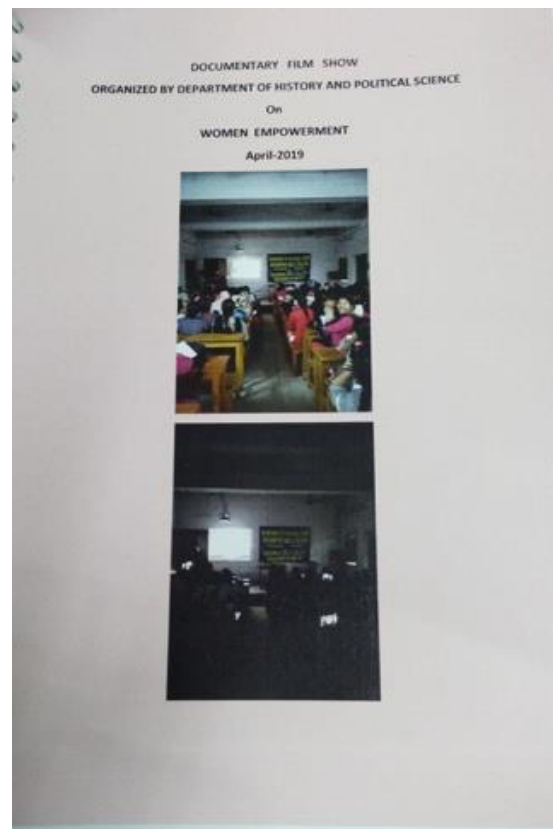
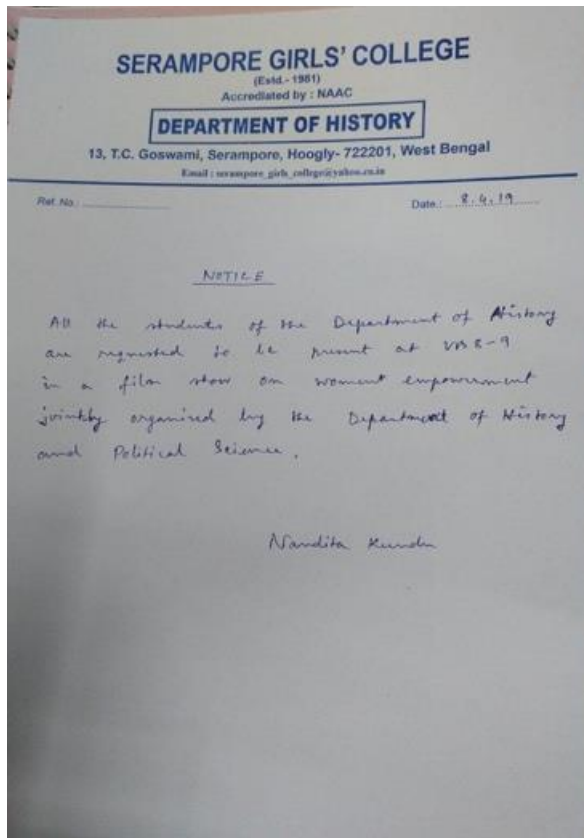

Time of the Event: 3rd sem- 11.30-12.30 pm & 5th sem- 2.00-3.00 pm

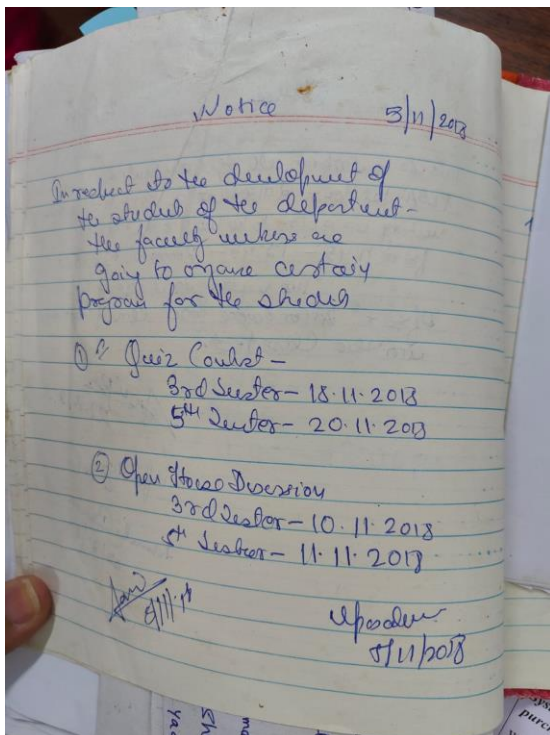

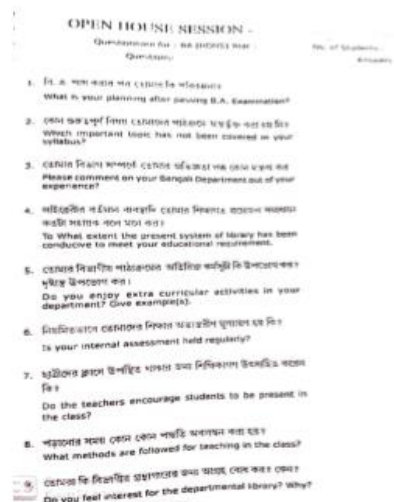
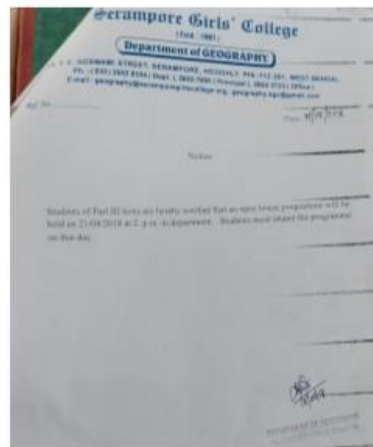
problems.
