THEORY  
 A message signal cannot be transmitted over long distances directly due to attenuation, distortion, interference and noise in any medium either wired or wireless. A suitable high frequency signal called carrier signal needs to be modulated by the low frequency message signal so that the message can be transmitted efficiently over long distances.

MODULATION:  
 Modulation is a scheme which alters some characteristics of the high frequency signal, called the carrier signal in accordance with the instantaneous value of the low frequency message signal called the modulating signal.
