- The programme ended successfully on a very positive note.

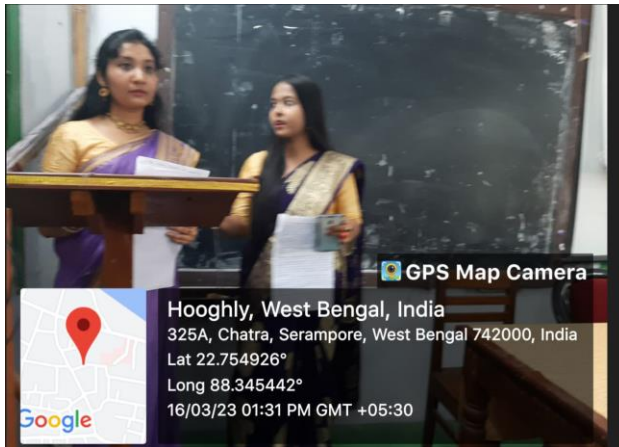

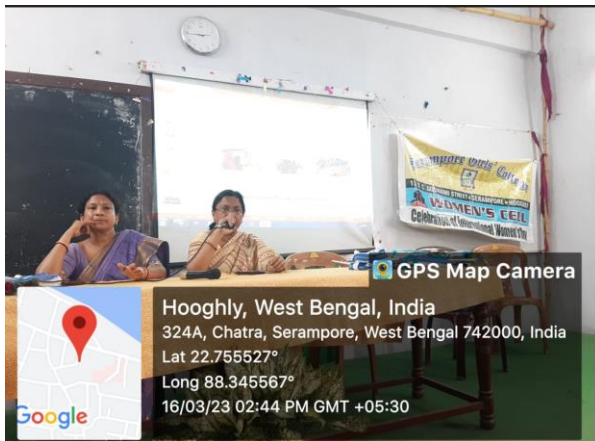

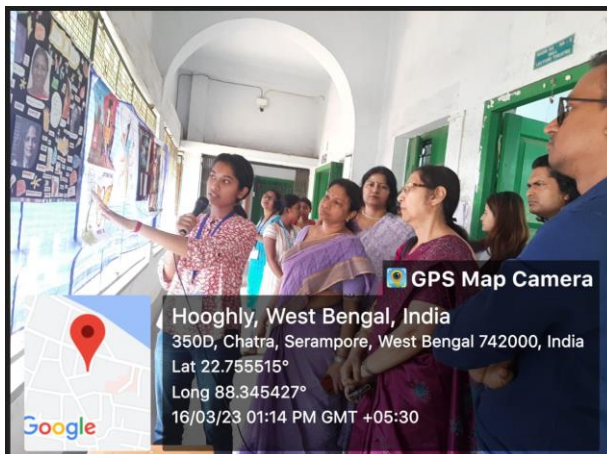

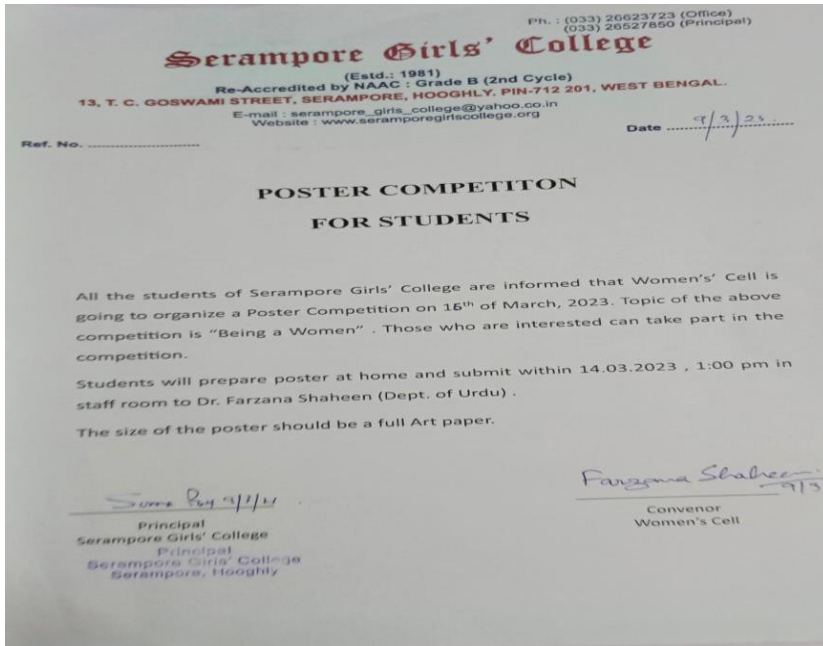

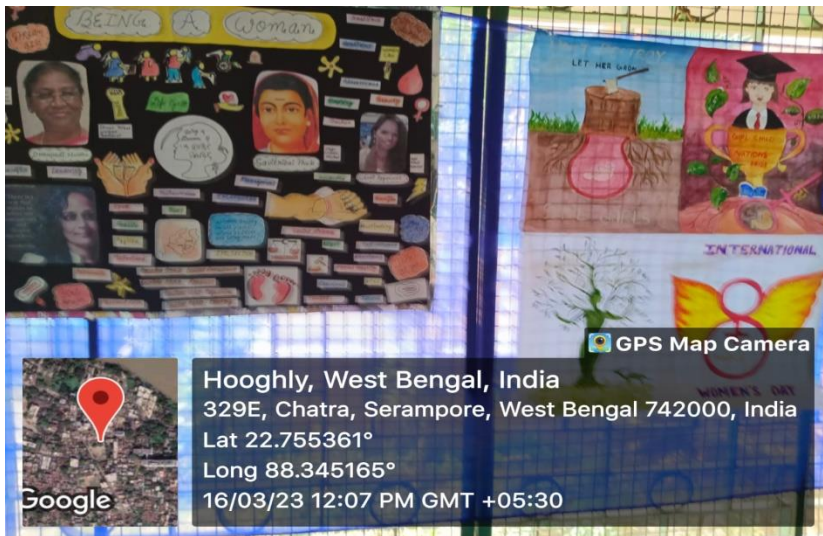

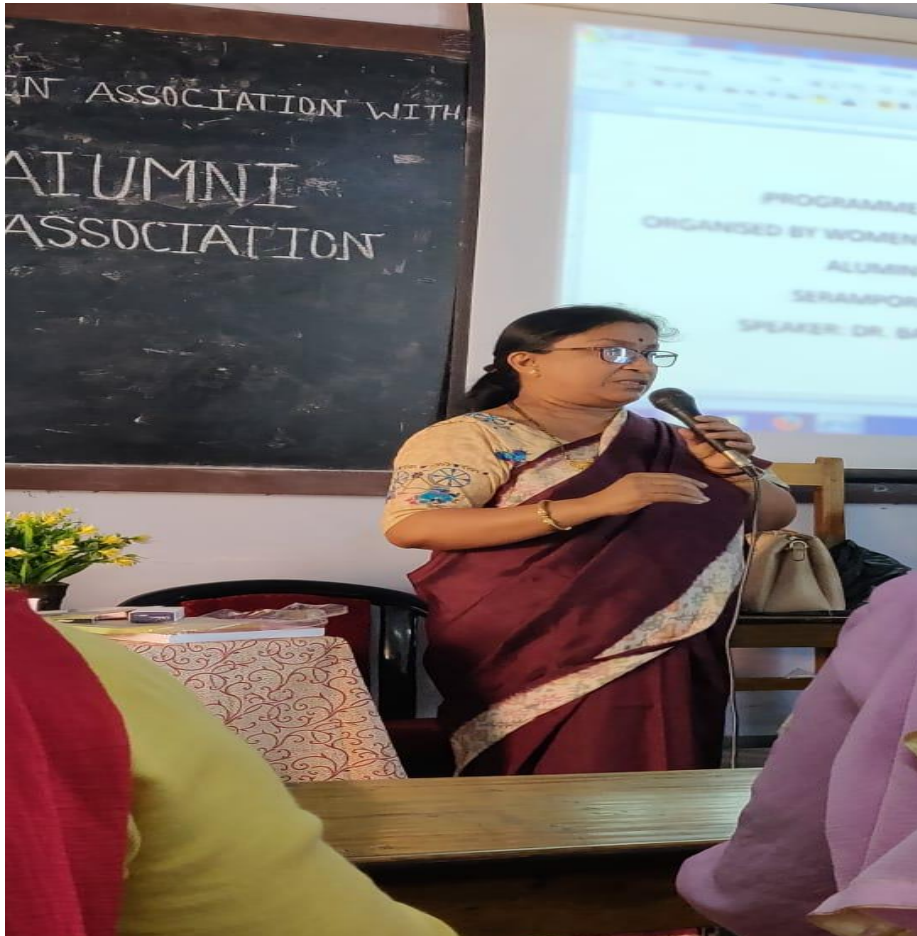
